Maths

This term we will be looking at:

Position and direction – measuring, drawing and calculating angles.

Time – reading and writing the time on an analogue and digital clock, converting between digital and analogue time and problem solving.

Fractions, decimals and percentages – finding equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages, comparing fractions, decimals and percentages, adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions, finding fractions of amounts, rounding decimals, multiplying and dividing decimals by whole numbers, finding percentages of amounts and solving fractions, decimals and percentages problems.

Ratio and proportion – calculating ratio and proportion and use and calculate scale factors.

Algebra – solving one step and two step rules, solving an expression when a letter is given a value.

Statistics – read and interpret line graphs and pie charts and calculate the mean of a set of data.

Shape – recognise 3d shapes and compare and classify based on their properties and calculate the radius, diameter and circumference of a circle.

Measure – to recognise and convert metric and imperial measures.

English

This term we will be looking at two texts –

The Selfish Giant by Oscar Wilde

We will be writing descriptive pieces, diaries, newspaper reports and retelling the story from the giant's point of view. Children will be taught: expanded noun phrases, prepositional phrases, the use of semi-colons, relative clauses, modal verbs, passive voice and parenthesis.

The Deepest Dark by Chris Hadfield

We will be writing a biography about Chris Hadfield and a non-chronological report about space. Children will be taught subjunctive form, cohesion, present perfect form, colons and dashes.

Religious Education

We will study three units this term:

Local Church – we will be learning about Jesus' mission to spread the Good News as according to the prophet Isaiah. We will also be looking at our local Diocese and the work carried out.

Eucharist – we will learn how this is a living memorial of Jesus' sacrifice and the links between Passover and the Last Supper.

Lent/Easter – we will be preparing for this special time.

History

This term we will be looking at the Victorians, The Industrial Revolution and Local History. We will find out why this period of British History is called the Victorian era, who Queen Victoria was, about other significant people of the era and how and why the British Empire expanded. We will also look at how the Industrial Revolution change how and where people lived, the importance of steam, coal and the improvement of working condition.

Computing

This term we will be looking at Handling data with flat-file databases – we will look at how a flat-file database can be used to organise data in records
Programming with variables in games - exploring the concept of variables in programming through games in Scratch

Art

This term we will be looking at different weaving techniques which children will use to design and create their own woven pattern. We will also be looking and printing, focusing on the artist William Morris. Children will learn how to design and make their own printing block to create a final piece.

Music

This term there will be no Music.

Science

The Science topics we will study are:

Forces – we will be learning how forces affect everything around us. We will learn about the effects of gravity, friction, air and water resistance as well simple mechanisms.

Earth and Space – we learn about the movement of the sun, moon and Earth, why we have day and night and different seasons, moon phases.
