Maths

This term we will be looking at:

Number and Place Value: Recapping Autumn Term and focusing on rounding to the nearest 10,100 and 100.

Addition and Subtraction: Round and adjust, adding and subtracting 4 digit numbers.

Shape – Angles: Recognising, comparing and ordering different types of angles.

Position and Direction: Using co-ordinates in the first quadrant.

Multiplication and Division: To use short multiplication and short division with 2 and 3 digit numbers.

Fractions: Recapping Autumn term focusing on improper fractions, mixed number fractions and equivalents.

Decimals – Linked to Money: Adding, subtracting, dividing numbers to 2 decimal places.

Measure: converting between different units of measure such as kg and L.

Statistics: Reading scales of 25, 250, 1000 with equal parts and present data in tables/graphs.

Come and See

We will study three units this term and study a different faith:

Local Church – Community: The experience of community is an essential and enjoyable part of life for people of every age and faith. The cycle of a year and the span of a lifetime contain occasions for regular celebrations as well as unexpected surprises, when people want to celebrate with family, friends and communities.

Eucharist – Relating: Being thoughtful for life, for people and gifts, is a vital part of our relationships with one another. When praise and appreciation are experienced, we are enabled to relate on a deeper level.

Lent/Easter – Giving: Life, especially family life, or life in school, is full of opportunities for self-giving.

History

We are not learning any new topics in History in the Spring Term but are always referring back to previous learning of Pre-historic Britain and the Romans from the Autumn Term.

P.E.

This term we will be looking at invasion games such as Hockey and Rugby and Net and Wall games such as Tennis and Dodgeball.

Science

The Science topics we will study are:

Animals including Humans – Learning about skeletons, bones and muscles in Humans and looking at different animal skeletons. Vertebrates and Invertebrates.

Plants – Learning about a plant's life cycle.

Computing

This term we will be looking at publishing and programming looking at Desktop publisher and repetition in games.

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Geography

This term we will be looking at Italy and Greece, focusing on using maps, place knowledge and GIS (Geography Information Systems) to describe these countries' landscapes, places and compare them to the UK.

Art

This term we will be printing and making 3D pots linking to our Geography topics of Italy and Greece.

D.T.

We will be looking at Food and Nutrition and linking it to our Italian Topic in Geography, discovering Italian Cuisine.

Music

This term we will be listening to music linked to Our Easter Reflection and using the Wigan Music Service to continue learning different string instruments.

RSHE

This term we will be looking at Online Safety and Mental Well-being.

This term we will be conversing about Epiphany, Family, Hobbies and Easter.
