## Maths

This term we will be looking at:

**Place value** – numbers to 10,000,000, Roman numerals, rounding whole and decimal number, negative numbers

**Four Calculations** – + and - mentally and written to 4 digits; x and ÷ using known facts; x and ÷ by 10, 100 and 1000; short division, long division, formal long multiplication, multiples and factors, prime numbers, square numbers, cube numbers and problem solving.

**Fractions** – compare, order and simplify fractions, add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions find fractions of amounts, recognise tenths, hundredths and decimal equivalent.

## Come and See

We will study three units this term and study a different faith:

**Domestic Church** – We will discuss how our talents, skills and qualities affect others – how we can become peacemakers

**Baptism/Confirmation** - Christians believe that everyone is invited to share in the life and work of God through Baptism. The Bible recounts God's invitations to people to share in his life and work: among them Moses, Samuel, the prophets, Mary and the apostles.

**Advent** - Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus, the promised one, on 25 December. It is preceded by the season of Advent, a time of preparation. It focuses on Jesus' coming in history as a time to wait in joyful hope for Him to come in glory at the end of time.

**Judaism** – Looking at the Shofah, Rosh Hashanah and Mitveh.

## History

We will be studying the British Monarchy; in particular King Charles II. How he came to be on the throne, his life and family. Along with the charities he is interested in.

We will also be studying the Tudor monarchy and how it changed Britain today; from how Henry Tudor VII became king, how and why Henry VIII broke ties with the Catholic Church and how the Tudor monarchy ended.

## Computing

This term we will be looking at sharing information through computer systems and how people work collaboratively even though they are from different places. We will also be looking programming in Scratch and creating algorithms which include conditional statements and selection.

## Art

This term we will be drawing portraits of Henry VIII, looking at the skills of accuracy, shading, the effect of light, using scale and proportion. As well as, techniques such as shading, blending and hatching.

## Music

Listening to various styles of music including modern and historical. Children will develop their skills to recall sounds and describe them using musical vocabulary.

## Science

The Science topics we will study are:

**Materials** – comparing everyday materials by their properties. We will be looking at dissolving substances to make a solution. Through practical work, we will look at different techniques that can be used to separate mixtures.

**Changes** – We will look at how materials can be irreversibly changed to form new materials.

This term we will be looking at gymnastics and dance.
