Maths

This term children will begin to develop a good understanding of number through various number rhymes. Children will continually orally count up to 5 and then up to 10. This term we will learn all about the Number 1- going on a number 1 hunt, using number blocks and number songs to help deepen our understanding- Hickory dickory dock will be another key song this term.

Children will also talk about the position of objects- in on under, behind and in front. We will end the term by sequencing simple events of our daily routine.

Phonics

This term, children will begin to develop their listening and attention skills through various games and activities from Letters and sounds, phase 1. Activities include listening to various noises and sounds from the environment, copying sounds and actions and using instruments to distinguish between loud and quiet sounds.

Children will learn various nursery rhymes- there will be two nursery rhymes each term that children will learn.

Please practice these at home.

<u>P.E.</u> – In P.E, children will explore topics:

Gymnastics and Dance

Children will develop the ability to move in a range of ways, increase the ability to move around and onto equipment as well as creating movement to music.

Physical development

Physical development is very important in Pre-school, as developing these skills help to support children's future writing skills.

Children will have opportunities to develop shoulder and wrist pivots during continuous provision activities.

Additionally children will take part in 'dough disco' as we focus on developing finger strength.

Children will begin to develop physically as they take part in 'Squiggle whilst you wiggle'. This will help support children to create different patterns and marks.

RE

This year in Pre-school, we are creating our own RE curriculum. We will be looking at topics:

'Creation and Covenant' and 'Prophecy and Promise.'

Children will begin to learn our school prayers.

RSHE

This term during RSHE, we will be learning about 'Families' 'People who care for us' and 'Caring friendships'.

Library sessions will start on:

Topic- Our topics over the next term will focus on: All about me

What they look like- children will learn how to use a paintbrush with control when creating lines and circles as they paint a self portrait.

How old am I- we will have a party to celebrate one of our teddy bear's birthday and share our own experiences.

Who is in their family-children will look at family photographs and talk about who is in their family.

What body parts they have and how they need to look after their body- children will sing along to Heads shoulders knees and toes to consolidate naming of body parts. Children will also have a visit from Nurse Fran.

Seasonal change- from Summer to Autumn- children will go on an Autumn walk in the forest! Please make sure children have wellies in school.

Colours- Each week during this topic will be linked to a colour. Children will make links to the world around them.
