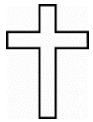


# St Gabriel's Early Years Main Curriculum Goals

To provide a 'breadth of experiences'

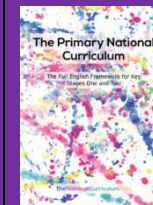
Have frequent opportunities for visits, visitors and real life experiences.
