Weekly Theme

On Wednesday: We welcomed a Flood Risk Engineer from Wigan Council to present an assembly and workshops for Key Stage 2 on the topic of 'flooding and water pollution'. Children were given some practical tips to protect their homes and belongings. In the afternoon, Year 5 and 6 took part in their annual sports day.

On Friday: Key Stage 1 classes took part in 'scooter' sessions which they really enjoyed. Year 4 celebrated Mass with Fr Paul in school.




