Please see separate letters detailing many Christmas events scheduled for this half - term. There are reply slips that need to be returned to school as soon as possible.

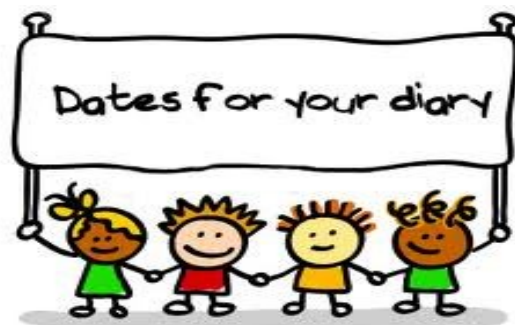
Family Mass
